This course will provide current and critical information pertaining to the treatment and care of diabetes to individuals primarily responsible for the management of diabetes within their own groups and communities. Diabetes topics that will be discussed in this course include: diabetes and bone, euglycemic DKA with SGLT2 inhibitors, screening for CAD, medication updates from ADA, finerenone in diabetic kidney disease, lipid management, diabetes technology, management of diabetes distress, and anaesthesia concerns with GLP-1 agonists.


